PREVENTATIVE CARDIAC SCREENINGS WITH INSPIRA HEALTH SPORTS MEDICINE

You train year-round to keep your body in peak shape, but are you forgetting about your most important muscle? A preventative cardiac screening with Inspira's Sports Medicine program can give you the edge you need, knowing your heart is safe and ready to compete.

Inspira's preventative cardiac screening program consists of a short, non-invasive, EKG screening, performed by a trained cardiovascular technician. These screenings can:

- Uncover heart problems before symptoms occur
- · Assess the function of your hearts electrical system
- Identify arrhythmias (irregular heartbeat), such as Tachycardia or Atrial Fibrillation
- Measure your hearts blood supply, which can indicate possibility of heart attacks

BIB LOOK UP:

PLEASE be sure to know your Bib Number before Check In. There will <u>NOT</u> be a Bib Look Up Station at the event. Find your number via:

- DelMoSports Mobile App
- RunSignUp Event Website

PHOTO ID:

Please have your Photo ID readily accessible to you as you approach to venue. You will be ID Checked before you Check In.

- Please keep your ID on you at all times.
- NO ID, NO RACE, NO BEER, NO EXCEPTIONS.

ITEMS TO PICK UP:

- Running Bib
- Safety Pins
- Competitor Shirt
- · Beer Token

Shirt exchange will be available on Friday starting at 7:00PM at the Info Tent. Be prepared to bring the shirt you are exchanging. First Come, First Serve while sizes last.

GEAR CHECK:

There is **NO** Gear Check; however, public parking is located near the start/finish so you will have access to your vehicle if you arrive early. You may also give your personal belongings to your family/friends spectating.

FREE PARKING:

We encourage you to find FREE parking at the "MudHen Approved Parking Lots" or street parking since the parking meters will not be in effect. **DO NOT** BLOCK someone's driveway and/or parking spots; you will be towed at your expense. See map on Schedule page.

ATHLETE TRACKING:

We encourage athletes and spectators to download the DelMoSports Elite Events Mobile App Powered by Cape May County Tourism before race weekend. Find it in the Apple Store and on Google Play by searching for "DelMoSports." The app features live athlete tracking, the event schedule, important push notifications, selfies and much more!

COURSE DETAILS:

There will be (1) Fill Station along the race course. If you feel that you will need water during your 5K and want to use this Fill Station, PLEASE be self sufficient and carry your own refillable bottle, cup or wear a hydration vest. Cups will not be available.

CUT OFF TIME:

There will be a time limit of 1 hour for the IPA 5K per the request of the Wildwood Police Department.

POST-RACE FOOD & BEER:

Enjoy a delicious post-race food spread provided by MudHen Brewing Co.! You must show your bib for Athlete Food. Spectator food and beer available for fee.

TIMING: OPEN

DelMoPRO will be handling the official timing. You MUST wear your running bib on the FRONT of your CHEST/ BODY. LIVE TRACKING will be available on the DelMoSports Elite Events Mobile App. Results and leaderboards will be available on the App as well.

 Overall Awards and Age Group awards are based on chip time.

BEER MILE

STICK AROUND AFTER THE IPA 5K TO WITNESS HISTORY AND CHEER ON OUR COMPETITORS FOR THE BEER MILE ISLAND CHAMPIONSHIPS!

- Starting at 7:45pm, all 10 Beer Mile competitors (5 men, 5 women) will commence this 2nd Annual event! It starts with a chug of a beer, running \(^1\)4 mile lap, another chug, another lap, etc. So in total, 4 beers and 1 Mile run.

BEER MILES RULES

- 1. Each competitor will consume a total of 4 12oz cups of beer and will run 4 laps around the designated race course on Rio Grande Ave in front of the MudHen Brewery.
- 2. The race format is as follows: Start, Chug 1, Lap 1, Chug 2, Lap 2, Chug 3, Lap 3, Chug 4, Lap 4, Finish. Competitors will line up on the start line with their first cup of beer in their hand.
- 3. Beer must be consumed before the lap begins, within the Transition Zone of the MudHen parking lot. The Transition Zone is a 9-meter zone where competitors must chug each beer. There will be a discard bin upon exit of the Transition Zone where cups must be discarded.
- 4. The race begins with competitors lined up on the starting line, drinking the first beer in the Transition Zone described in the step above. This ensures competitors cover a complete mile. Competitors can walk/move in the Transition Zone while drinking, but all beer must be consumed in the Transition Zone before setting off to run a lap.
- 5. All competitors must drink the provided Official Competition Beer – MudHen Brewing Co. MudHen Pils (a 4.6% ABV Pilsner) – provided in 12oz cups.
- 6. The cups of beer will be on a table inside the Transition Zone for each competitor to grab. There are no assigned spots on the table since all competitors are drinking the same beer.
- 7. Competitors who vomit before they finish the race will receive a 2:00 minute penalty. Race officials will assess and assign all penalties. If a competitor vomits more than 1 time in the race, they will still only receive 1 2:00 minute penalty in total.
- 8. If a competitor spills their beer while consuming and the Race Officials deem it to be more than a few drops and/or a competitive advantage, a 2:00 minute penalty will be assessed.
